- Provide explicit directions for tasks in order to keep students engaged and focused
- Frequently check for understanding and monitor students' computer use to ensure a productive learning experience
- Ensure that teaching is not limited to Chromebook use, but encompasses a variety of meaningful, curriculum related learning activities
